Eastern Idaho Public Health Teams Up with Greater Than AIDS and Walgreens to Provide Free HIV Testing and Information on National HIV Testing Day, Monday, June 27

WHAT:	On National HIV Testing Day, Eastern Idaho Public Health (EIPH) will be at participating Walgreens stores to provide free, rapid HIV testing onsite. Counselors will also answer questions about the latest HIV prevention and treatment options.
WHO:	Counselors from EIPH will be on hand to administer HIV tests and provide information.
WHEN:	Monday, June 27, 2022 from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
WHERE:	 Two Idaho Falls Walgreens locations: 1725 1st Street (corner of 1st Street and Woodruff) 1604 W. Broadway (corner of Broadway and Skyline Drive)
WHY:	Everyone should know their HIV status. The only way to do that is by getting a test. Knowing your HIV status gives you powerful information to help you take steps to keep

Since 2011, more than 72,000 free HIV tests have been provided as part of the annual program – including 15,300 self-tests provided during the height of COVID-19 to help fill the gap in HIV testing during the pandemic.
