 - CYA just received a \$1,000,000.00 grant, specific to learning loss during the pandemic. In order to utilize the funding, they will need to expand services to younger children (5th and 6th graders). They will hire additional staff and expand the workdays to accommodate the end of school day times. They will also expand services to Rigby and will bus students from the middle school to Idaho Falls. They will try and separate the age differences whenever possible. They will also purchase sustainable items. Payments will be made quarterly to CYA.
 - CYA will be participating in a traveling service project July 22 August 1. The Center will be closed during this time.
