Children's Mental Health Awareness Week - May 1 to 7

Teriann asked for ideas regarding Children's Mental Health Awareness Week at the last meeting and has compiled a list of suggested activities. Meeting participants were asked to vote on the topics they were interested in implementing. The top picks were partner with juvenile probation officers to provide children's mental health information to families, collaborate with juvenile corrections to show Paper Tigers or Resilience to offenders and their families, provide Jeff D information throughout the region, and ethics.

Crista Henderson made a motion to approve the January 20, 2017 CMH meeting minutes.

The Federation of Families poster contest was discussed. Steve Graci provided details about the poster contest. Teriann provided information regarding our past participation with the poster contest.

Children's Mental Health Awareness Week is May 1 – May 7. The Idaho Federation of Families is collecting information about various children's mental health activities happening throughout the state. Their plan is to communicate information about these activities through a press release and their website. If anyone has information about an activity, please provide it to Steve at sgraci@idahofederation.org. Children's Mental Health Awareness Week activities can take place anytime during the month not just during the designated week. Information about YES and the showing of Resilience will be part of Children's Mental Health Awareness Week.

The theme for the week will be "Keep the Ball Rolling." The Federation of Families is going to circulate an actual ball around the state and photographs will be taken of the ball in different places and during activities. Steve wants to start the ball in Region 7. Teriann will make arrangements with Rachael Kelley to pick up the ball when she is in Boise.

The group decided to participate in the poster contest this year. Rachel Kelley volunteered to head up the poster contest.

Steve Orme (Optum) announced they are having their first showing of Resilience in May. They are still looking for a venue so the date and time have not been announced yet. They are also planning to have a showing in Region 6 & 7. They are looking at Fort Hall as a potential location. Teriann asked about a showing in the more rural areas of the region. Optum currently only has one copy and wants to show it in areas where it can reach the most people. They will try to show it in other areas later in the year. The showing will be open to everyone and will be shown after 5:00 p.m.

Teriann asked for input from the group on how to go forward. We could collaborate with Optum during the May showings of Resilience. Laura Wallis said she would like to see showings throughout the year instead of just one big event. Teriann announced that we would have further discussion on this topic at the next meeting but that a decision needs to be made soon as May is quickly approaching.

Laura recommends we start gathering a list of children's mental health resources that are current, active, and helpful. Law enforcement provides very little information to families. It would be helpful to have a flyer provided to families from law enforcement with a list of available mental health resources in the area.

The Parent Network has officially changed its name from YES Parent Network to Parent Network so that the current network of parents can operate and gather information without having to go through the state approval process for everything. They will still work closely with the state and Pat Martell is their contact.
