5. PARTNERSHIP FOR SUCCESS (PFS) GRANT DISCUSSION | Ashley Billman

- Strengthening the Families training to teachers and parents in the community has been completed. The PFS grant funded the training and attendees will be invited to the next PFS Subcommittee meeting to explain their plan for implementation of the training in the community.
- Alternative activities for schools will be reported on next month.
- The first year of the PFS grant ended June 30, 2019. At the Prevention Subcommittee meeting on July 8, 2019, they will be reviewing next year's plan for spending. Prevention Subcommittee meetings are held on the 2nd Monday of each month at EIPH at 11:00 a.m.
- The PFS grant is sponsoring a Chukars game on September 4, 2019 to promote the prevention of underage drinking. Additional information will be available in the future.

6. OPERATION SHIELD PRESENTATION | Matthew Smith

There have been questions of what qualifies as a Substance Use Disorder Treatment Provider.
