**3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES | Samuel Hulse**

**4. FINANCIAL REPORT | Randy Rodriguez**

It was reported that the total FY20 year-to-date revenue is \$29,166.00 and total year-to-date expenditures are \$19,089.96. The YTD balance is \$10,076.04. With carryover dollars from previous years, the current fund balance is \$72,789.19. The total amount for grants awarded this fiscal year are \$4,043.00. **7. R7BHB 2020 PLANNING**

The Board discussed topics and strategic action items to address in 2020. The three items chosen were, 1) housing for people with behavioral health issues, 2) funding innovative community-based behavioral health programs via micro-grants, and 3) educating the community about the R7BHB and behavioral health issues in Region 7.



**Teriann Ness-Parker made a motion to approve setting goals around, housing, micro grants, and community outreach. Seconded by Randy Rodriquez. Motion passed**

The Board will continue to provide feedback on these goals and Mimi Taylor will update the progress.

**9. COMMUNITY REPORTS/ANNOUNCEMENTS**

- Darin Burrell announced that ICADD (Idaho Conference on Alcohol and Dreg Dependency) registration will open soon. The conference is May 18-21, 2020 at Boise State University. If the Board is going to fund scholarships again this year, the early bird sign-up ends April 1, 2020. A mini conference will be held in October in Pocatello at ISU. Mimi Taylor has sent out a survey regarding a mini ICADD. Please take a few minutes and provide input.
- Chairman Hulse announced the Region 7 Crisis Intervention Team training will be held April 6-10, 2020 at the College of Eastern Idaho. For additional information or to register, contact Doug Metcalf at [dmetcalf@co.bonneville.id.us](mailto:dmetcalf@co.bonneville.id.us).
- Mimi Taylor requested that Board members complete a survey from the Office of Drug Policy regarding prevention. Also, May is Mental Health Awareness Month and we need to nominate someone from our region for a Mental Health Advocacy award. In addition, Ashley Billman has resigned from the R7BHB so her seat, Prevention Specialist, will be available. We also have an opening for the Adult Corrections Representative.
- Shawn LaPray reported that the Behavioral Health Center at EIRMC has added new adolescent beds with their capacity increasing from 17 to 25 bed. Their adult capacity has also increased by five beds. EIRMC is actively recruiting for a Graduate Medical Education (GME) Director. They are going to have a psychiatric rotation. Psychiatrists will come to EIRMC to train and do their fellowship. Two doctors will start this year with two additional starting next year.




