- What are the services or opportunities your organization provides for the community? SPaRC partner with child welfare organizations preventatively and as a intervention. Information gathered through an assessment helps SPaRC create opportunities to strengthen families and support individuals by focusing on intervention and prevention efforts, coupled with delivering enhanced services and building stronger connections for youth and families with community partners.
- What are the communities/counties you provide your services in?
 BHB Regionwide (Bingham, Bonneville, Butte, Clark, Custer, Fremont, Jefferson, Lemhi, Madison, and Teton);
- 3. What has your organization completed in the last month? We had a meeting with 5 of our Region 7 judges and introduced SPaRC. It was a successful meeting with the judges seeing how SPaRC is a huge asset to their courts and the community.
- 4. What is your organization planning to work towards or planning to provide to the community in the coming month? We are reaching out to SRO's in the schools. Our goal is to help the youth not enter into any Juvenile Justice system and intervening with truancy or other light behaviors before it gets to that point. We are also starting a monthly luncheon meeting with different community resources and partners each month that we see as a great resource and partnership, that could help the youth and their families.
