Agenda item: Approval of 4/21/2017 meeting minutes. **Presenter:** Teriann Parker

Teriann asked for any changes to the April 21, 2017 meeting minutes. No changes were proposed.

Agenda item: Children's Mental Health Awareness Week **Presenter:** Teriann Parker

Teriann asked if there were any questions regarding the report Laura Wallis gave at last month's R7BHB meeting about the Children's Mental Health Awareness Week activities in May.

Lisa Koller won the first annual Voice of Idaho award for the State of Idaho and Logan Zuck won the Regional Empowerment award.

Teriann reported that one of the CMH Awareness Week posters from Region 7 was one of three winners chosen by the Idaho Federation of Families.

Brenda Valle said she thought the Resilience screening in Fort Hall in May was lacking in school participation. Teriann shared that she had heard from Jim Sporleder and James Radford at the premier showing of Resilience in Boise on May 13, 2017 that some of the schools in Idaho were not going to show the films Paper Tigers & Resilience due to the coarse language. Jim and James also told Teriann that Sherri Ybarra, Idaho Superintendent of Public Schools, is not encouraging the film to be played in schools for staff or students. Teriann would welcome any ideas from Optum regarding how to get this film into the schools.

Teriann presented an idea for next year's CMH Awareness Week activities. She would like to get support to start working early next year with Compass Academy on their yearly More Than a Stigma project. Compass Academy is part of District 91 and they actively support and participate in community-based projects. The group discussed involving not only Compass Academy but other schools and districts, as well. There are many projects happening in schools around the region. This topic will remain on the agenda for further discussion.

Agenda item: CMH Mission Statement and Committee Structure Discussion **Presenter:** Teriann Parker

Teriann read the Mission Statement of the CMH Committee. She opened for discussion the possibility of having seats on the CMH Committee similar to the R7BHB. Mimi stated that currently, anyone who attends the CMH meeting is considered to be on the committee and is able to vote on issues.

Following the discussion, the group decided not to have designated seats on the committee. Instead, they will request individuals attending the meeting to declare they want to actively participate and become an official CMH Committee member. Only official committee members will have voting rights.

Janet suggested doing a survey to see who is interested and what their involvement would be. Mimi said she could send out an email to get that information if that is the direction the committee wanted to go. Teriann ended the discussion due to time restraints. No decision was made and the topic will be added to July 2017 agenda.
