

The [Idaho Food Code \(Section 2-102.12\)](#) requires each food establishment to have a minimum of one (1) accredited food protection manager. This person does **NOT** need to be present at the establishment during all hours of food service and preparation. Currently, this requirement can be done by successfully completing one of the nationally accredited food safety examinations listed below.
