 - Dave Peters shared that they have 3 crisis contracts in Idaho Falls with 3 different agencies: Stewards of Children, East Idaho Youth Homes, and Gus House; if parents are concerned, they can take their child to a center and the facility can do a crisis screening then choose to admit the individual for 72 hours and Children's Mental Health pays for this, SMH can approve a longer stay up to six (6) days; There are also child protection contracts; they are expecting this process to change July 1 once Magellan takes over, Dave will update this subcommittee as more details come available
