- -Main goal or purpose for PFS grant: To prevent underage drinking, opioid misuse, and methamphetamine use in communities. Funds CANNOT be used for substance misuse intervention, treatment, or recovery.
- -Target populations: American Indians, youth 18 and under, young adults ages 18-25 and Idahoans living in rural communities.
- -Award period: July 1, 2024 June 30, 2026, with monthly reporting on activities completed
- -Award amount: \$118,000 for two years, cannot exceed \$59,000 per fiscal year.
- -Activities planned: 3rd Millennium Classroom Courses, Positive Action Parenting, Drug and Alcohol Trends Education (D.A.T.E.) webinar (needing to pivot this curriculum to something else as contact has not been successful with group that does this), Screening, Brief Intervention, Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) training for providers
- -Media: Billboard space district-wide via radio/TV/social media ad space, banners, posters, schools, public areas, Idaho Falls Zoo
- -Outreach: BeTheParents campaign dissemination (created and supplied by ODP), community event participation district-wide. Participation with community coalitions including Fremont County Resource and Collaboration Effort (RACE) group for schools, Clark County RACE, Community Youth in Action (CYA).

-Suicide Prevention efforts: Community Suicide Prevention focusing on postvention. Dr Matt Larsen did a study that identified higher risk for adult white males who smoke, have high stress in a romantic relationship, recent relationship change, little to no warning signs recognized. Looking into changing wall @ Jefferson County Lake to reflect 988 for Suicide Prevention instead of the previous crisis phone number. Care card created and disseminated to schools in each county to assist staff with how to direct those affected to helpful resources.
