Free Flu Vaccine Clinic for Uninsured/Underinsured Children & Adults Saturday, December 5 from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at EIPH

Eastern Idaho – Receiving the flu vaccine each year is the single best prevention strategy against getting ill with influenza ("the flu"). The flu is a serious respiratory illness that results in approximately 36,000 deaths each year. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends a yearly flu vaccine for everyone 6 months of age and older.

Being uninsured or underinsured limits people's opportunities to receive needed preventative services. This clinic will give access to people who are in need of protective immunization, not only to protect themselves but the people around them.

As immunization champions, Eastern Idaho Public Health will be holding a **FREE** flu vaccine immunization clinic for uninsured/underinsured children and adults. All of the clinic details are listed below:
