Human Papillomavirus (HPV) is a group of viruses linked to multiple health conditions, including six different types of cancer. HPV is a very common virus; nearly 80 million people—about one in four—are currently infected in the United States. About 14 million people, including teens, become infected with HPV each year. Fortunately, there is a vaccine available to prevent HPV infection.

As cancer prevention advocates and as a part of the statewide HPV Vaccination Week 2019, Eastern Idaho Public Health will be providing **FREE** HPV vaccine throughout the health district during the week of February 11-15, 2019.
