HPV Vaccine Available at No Out-of-Pocket Cost in February Vaccine Available at all Eastern Idaho Public Health (EIPH) Offices

(SE Idaho) – Human Papillomavirus (HPV) is a group of viruses linked to multiple health conditions, including six different types of cancer. HPV is a very common virus; nearly 80 million people—about one in four—are currently infected in the United States. About 14 million people, including teens, become infected with HPV each year. Fortunately, there is a vaccine available to prevent HPV infection.

As cancer prevention advocates and as a part of the state-wide HPV Vaccination Campaign 2020, Eastern Idaho Public Health will be providing HPV vaccine throughout the health district during the month of February. There is no out-of-pocket cost to our clients receiving this vaccine. Information is listed below:
